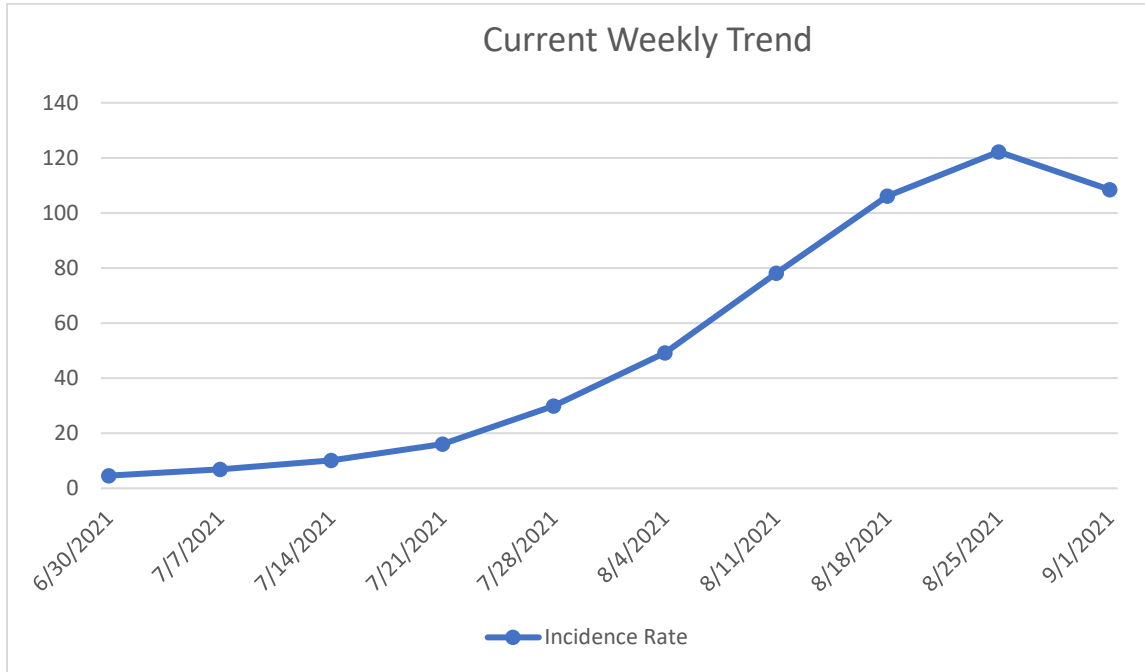




## Weekly Update

September 2, 2021



This chart depicts the weekly 7-day average incidence rate as reported by KDPH every Wednesday (based on the average of the previous 7 days). Our highest rate since the pandemic began was 85.9 in January 2021. This week we are at 108.1. This is down from 122.2 this time last week. Our highest average rate to date was 138.3 on 8/23/21.
