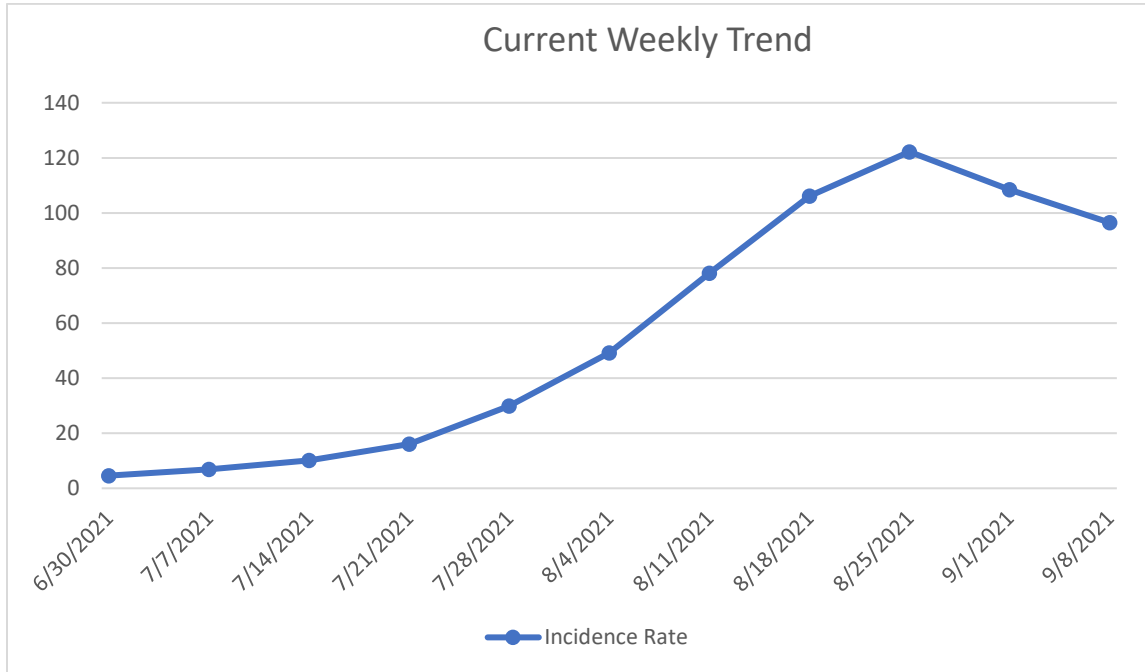




Weekly Update

September 9, 2021



This chart depicts the weekly 7-day average as reported by KDPH every Wednesday (based on the average of the previous 7 days). Our highest rate since the pandemic began was 85.9 in January 2021. This week we are at 96.5. This is down from 108.1 this time last week. Our highest rate was 138.3 on 8/23/21.
